International Colour Day (ICD)

International Colour Day (ICD) celebration started in 2008 when proposed by the Portugal Society for Illumination and accepted by the International Association for Colour (AIC). AIC decision is based on 21st March phenomenon when a day and night are of the same length, which symbolically refers to the complementary nature of light and darkness, light and shadow. On 21st March 2014 Croatian Colour Society celebrated ICD for the first time and continued every coming year.
